Upon retiring, they returned to Israel in 2008, where they now serve as Directors of the Jerusalem Prayer Center.



The central feature of the Jerusalem Prayer Center is The Upper Room, an interactive prayer room designed for meeting with God on a personal level.

"Prayer is the first Great Commission Strategy. The first disciples prayed for 10 days, then on the Day of Pentecost, they witnessed for 10 minutes and 3000 were saved!"

On this Mission Trip you will...

- Stand on Mt. Carmel where Elijah “prayed down” the 450 Prophets of Baal and pray Elijah’s great prayer of spiritual warfare.
- Worship on a wooden (1st Century replica) boat as you cross the Sea of Galilee just like Jesus and His disciples 2000 years ago.
- Visit Capernaum and the prayer garden next to the excavations of Simon Peter’s house. Capernaum was the home base of Jesus’ Galilee Ministry.
- Worship on Sunday morning on site at the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus gave “the Sermon on the Mount.” Message: “What Jesus Taught About Prayer in the Sermon on the Mount.”
- Visit the River Jordan and have the opportunity to be baptized where Jesus was baptized by John.
- Visit the Wailing Wall where the Jewish people gather to pray in mourning. You will be able to pray in joy in anticipation of the return of Jesus, the Morning Star.
- Spend four inspiring mornings studying and praying in the Jerusalem Prayer Center with Dale & Anita Thorne, IMB Representatives to Israel.
- Prayer walk for 4 afternoons in the Old City of Jerusalem where Jesus and His disciples conducted 3 ministry tours, the last resulting in His arrest and crucifixion.
- Pray at the Temple Mount where Pentecost happened and God’s Spirit was poured out on people from many nations.
- Visit Gethsemane and pray in the Garden where Jesus prayed before His arrest.
- Walk the path that Jesus walked to Golgotha and see the Hill of the Skull.
- Worship and celebrate the Lord’s Supper at the Garden Tomb. It is empty. . .for He is risen!

HOW?

- **Ask God if you should go, and if so, to provide the resources.**
- **Make the commitment and the deposit of \$350.00.**
- **Gather a support team of 5 people who will lift you up in prayer from now through the trip.**

The Jerusalem Prayer Center is located in a historic, one hundred-year-old building that was once part of the American Colony of Jerusalem. Baptists have owned the building for the past 40 years. The JPC is positioned on the dividing line between Arab East Jerusalem and Jewish West Jerusalem. This location places it on a strategic site to facilitate prayer for ALL peoples of the Holy Land and beyond. Prayer walking through the ancient walled city of Jerusalem and visiting the Garden Tomb are only a five-minute walk away.

The Center is a place where believers can intercede for the peoples of Israel and the world.

Banners with scriptures in Arabic, Hebrew & English hung throughout the room call you to meet with God. Special stations offer you the facility for expressing your prayers through journaling, drawing, interceding before maps of Israel and the world, kneeling before the cross and reading God’s Word.

The Schedule will include:

- **Practical training in intercessory prayer.**
- **Daily prayer-walking opportunities (Jerusalem, Galilee & other sites).**
- **How to set up an interactive prayer room and conduct an effective prayer ministry.**
- **Interaction with workers who will share what God is doing among their people group.**
